

Arrangements for Exclusion

As part of its disciplinary sanctions the School employs fixed term exclusions. These exclusions can be for a variety of breaches of the School's Behaviour Policy.

The number of days are dependent upon the nature of the offence and whether the student concerned has incurred previous exclusions or other disciplinary sanctions.

A letter will be sent to the parents/carers detailing the reason for the exclusion and the length of the exclusion. Work will be made available to the parents/carers to collect on behalf of the student.

In more extreme cases the School may issue a permanent exclusion. This is in the case of very serious breach or persistent breaches of the School's Code of Conduct. As for a fixed term exclusion the parents/carers will be issued a letter detailing the reason why the permanent exclusion has been administered.

In the case of a permanent exclusion the School will again provide work for the student but upon the sixth day the student becomes the responsibility of the Local Authority.
